Pursuant to the decision taken in the 63rd meeting of Board of Directors of State Forest Corporation a High Level Committee of following officers is constituted;

1. Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu.
2. Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir.
3. General Manager SFC, (East Circle Doda)
4. General Manager SFC, (North Circle Sopore)
5. Director Finance, SFC.
6. Chief General Manager (R&D) SFC.

The committee shall work out the modalities for application of:

- (a) empowering the MD SFC to sanction escalation upto 10% on the total project cost as computed on norm rates in special circumstances involving meagre volumes, unforeseen circumstances, and peculiar site conditions and in Forest Conservation Act cases requiring removal of trees on urgent basis. The project components in such cases to be verified by an independent committee of officers; and
- (b) Empowering the Steering committee of SFC to provide an additional escalation of 10% on the total project cost as computed on norm rates under conditions mentioned above.

The committee shall furnish its report within two weeks so that, it can be considered in the next meeting of Board of Directors of State Forest Corporation.
