Subject: Revised proposal to allow use of 2.825 hectare of forest land for construction of road from Admarg to Mohu under PMGSY in Ramban Forest Division.

Reference: Minutes of the 6th Forest Advisory Committee meeting held on 13th December 2011 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (Agenda Item no. 61.02).

Sanction is hereby accorded to use 2.825 hectare of forest land for construction of road from Admarg to Mohu under PMGSY by Executive Engineer, PMGSY Division, Ramban in Compartments 34 and 35/ Banihal in Mahu Block of Banihal Range of Ramban Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 25,34,025/-
ii	Compensation of trees/poles	₹ 15,15,320/-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	₹ 2,82,500/-
Total:-		₹ 43,31,845/-

2 (a) Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved.

Species	Trees (30-40cm & above)	Poles (20-30cm & 10- 20cm)	Saplings (0-10cm)	Total
Deodar green	104	49	34	187

(b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.

3. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. This shall be done under the technical guidance and supervision of the Soil Conservation Department J&K.
4. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land other than the dumping sites identified for the purpose.
5. The User Agency shall construct retaining/ breast walls around the dumping sites and ensure that the debris dumped is rammed properly

- using machines/ implements so that it does not get washed away and is stabilized/ rehabilitated properly. This should further be consolidated by planting soil binding species of grass and other vegetation.
6. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
 7. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
 8. The User shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
 9. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 43,31,845/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
 10. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
 11. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
 12. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
