The appointees figuring at Serial No. 1 & 2 shall report to the Director, Soil Conservation Department and those figuring at Serial No. 3, 4 & 5 shall report to the Chief Wildlife Warden, J&K Jammu for further postings. They shall be allowed to join in the Department only after production / scrutiny of the following certificate in original:-

- Academic / Technical Qualification Certificate
- Matriculation Date of Birth Certificate.
- Health Certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer.
- Permanent Resident Certificate.
- Relevant category certificate (in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories).

- vi. Certificate from the General Manager, DIC concerned and Deputy Director, Employment concerned to the effect that no loan under self employment schemes has been taken.

Their appointment shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a) Each appointee shall give an undertaking in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that in case adverse report about his / her character and antecedents is received from the Additional Director General of Police, CID, J&K, to whom a reference shall be made by Head of the Department concerned, the candidate shall have no right to claim his / her appointment as Range Officer and his / her appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio.
- b) Verification of the qualification certificate / reserved category certificate (wherever applicable) from the concerned issuing authorities.

Salary of these appointees shall not be drawn and disbursed to them unless satisfactory report in respect of (a) and (b) above is received.

The appointees shall be on probation for a period of two years. Their appointment shall be governed by the provisions of SRO-400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009 issued by the Finance Department.

The inter-se-seniority of the appointees shall be notified separately.
