Subject - Release State Share under National Livestock Mission during 2017-18.

In continuation to Government Order No: 70-FST of 2018 dated: 12-03-2018, sanction is accorded to the release of an amount of Rs 26.7275 lacs (Rupees Twenty six lakh seventy two thousand seven hundred fifty) only as State Share under Centrally Sponsored Scheme "National Livestock Mission" in favour of Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K, Jammu for utilization during the current financial year 2017-18 for implementation of approved works Plan for development of land under the activity "Fodder Production" as per Compartment wise break up of funds given at Annexure 'A' to this Government Order.

The release of funds is subject to the fulfillment of following conditions:

- i. The expenditure shall be booked strictly as per approved Action plan and as per guidelines of the scheme;
- ii. The expenditure shall be incurred after fulfilling all codal formalities;
- iii. The funds so released shall not be available for re-appropriation/diversion at any level;
- iv. The utilization certificate is furnished to the Administrative Department after expenditure is incurred for its submission to Government of India/Animal & Sheep Husbandry Department;
- v. There shall be no overlapping of funding from any other source such as CSS/Flagship programme/ Capex Budget or any other source of funding;
- vi. FA/CAG of Directorate of Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K shall vouchsafe the utilization of funds;
- vii. The progress report both financial and physical shall be submitted to Administrative Department;
- viii. The implementing agency shall ensure that the expenditure as well as covering of the area has not already been covered/incurred out of any other scheme under Capex Budget or Non-plan Budget;
- ix. The department shall ensure that funds released are utilized prudently and judiciously and in no case they should book the expenditure just for the sake of spending.
- x. The other terms and conditions shall remain the same as already communicated vide Government order No: 70-FST of 2018 dated: 12-03-2018.




